

## CONTEMPORARY UPDATE

### THE DESIGN BRIEF

Architects Dittrich Hudson Vasetti were called in to improve a Bristol home with an existing lean-to kitchen extension, the proportions of which were too small for the house. The owners wanted a new space for cooking, eating, entertaining and relaxing, and a separate utility room. Building into the side return created a dining area open to a new contemporary kitchen and the more traditional living

space of the original house, while the previous extension was reconfigured to create a utility room. Triangular glazing above the black aluminium bi-fold doors, together with rooflights, maximises light. White-painted render ties it in to the rest of the house.

### THE COST

The project cost £60,000, including the kitchen and utility room. ▶
